Pau d'arco has a long history in herbal medicine around the world. Pau d'arco is used frequently in the herbal treatment of cancer and infections, including candidiasis and other yeast infections. Pau d'arco is also used for allergies, arthritis, diabetes, flu, lupus, parasites, skin diseases, and ulcers. It is used for fevers, infections, colds, flu, syphilis, cancer, respiratory problems, skin ulcerations, boils, dysentery, gastro-intestinal issues, arthritis, prostatitis, and circulation disturbances.

Dosage:

Take 1 Vegi-Capsule, 2-3 times daily or as directed by a qualified health professional.

Ingredients Explained

Pau D-Arco Inner Bark (*Tabebuia Heptaphylla*) - Pau d'arco (pronounced pow-d-arco) is a large tree that grows in the Amazon rain forest and in tropical areas of South America. The botanical names for the species most commonly used are *Tabebuia heptaphylla* and *Tabebuia impetiginosa*. The tree is called taheebo or lapacho in South America. We use only the most potent portion of the bark – the inner bark. It is the inner bark of pau d'arco that is used as an herbal medicine, most notably in the treatment of cancer and infections.

Pau d'arco is also employed in herbal medicine systems in the United States and Europe for lupus, diabetes, ulcers, leukemia, allergies, liver disease, Hodgkin's disease, osteomyelitis, Parkinson's disease, and psoriasis. It is a popular remedy for Candida and yeast infections.
